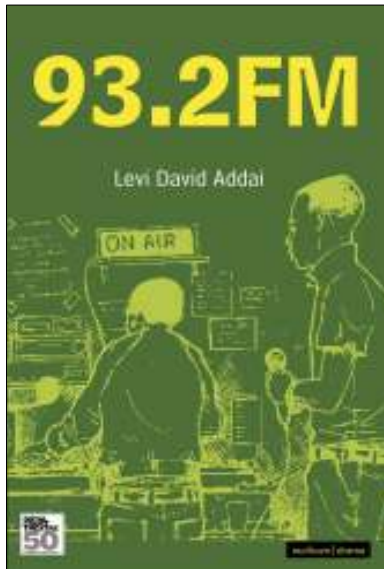


93.2FM by Levi David Addai
