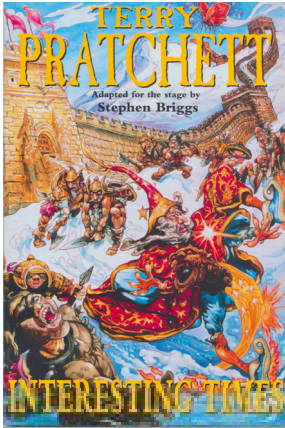


## Interesting Times by Terry Pratchett
