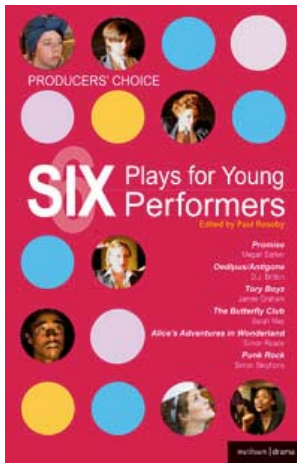


Tory Boyz by James Graham
